

THE HENRY PETERS CHARITY - Annual Report to the Parish Council 2021/22

The money in this charity was left by Henry Peters for the benefit of Wouldham residents who needed medical help. After many years of not being used, the trustees and the Parish Council decided to use the money to pay for transport to hospitals and Doctors surgeries when the cost or availability wasn't around.

In 2020 the Charity spent £371 on transport and some food (for a struggling resident), in 2021 the charity spent £510 on 12 trips to local hospitals. At the end of the year the balance stood at £3836.
