The borough has lost 2 beat officers but replaced with 3. (Cole wasn't mentioned as a replacement) Parish groups have been tweaked to ensure fairer cover by beat officers.

It was suggested they see parishes face to face every six months and written reports in between. Zara later said every three months.

I reported that Cole had been to a PC meeting and had attended a speedwatch session as well as his own attendance at the end of Knowle Road and No Entry.

Question- Did Wouldham PC respond to query about the last time we had seen beat officer? Dylan at No Entry today issued tickets.

Issues over the summer:

- Catapults Not considered an offensive weapon. Movement in govt to get this changed. If used
 against animals, catapults can be seized cruelty to animals.
- Alison Finch- Public Space Protection order on catapults can be used as a deterrent, clerks to feedback to her of incidents.
- Shoplifting- lots of community events to address this.
- ASB rose over the summer- nuisance vehicles, shoplifting & catapults.
- Ongoing and future operations around Halloween, Diwali and Xmas.
